

ART MAJOR

B.A. or B.S. degrees: the B.A. students are required to take a minimum of 90 s.h. of Liberal Arts courses, while for the B.S. degree a minimum of 60 s.h. is required.

Art Majors can have a maximum of 60 s.h. of Art Department courses count toward the 122 s.h. required for graduation.
