

Meeting Minutes, March 15, 2005. at the Shultis house in Otego

Present: Gary, Neil, Fran Toombs, Sue Botzow, Jeff Shultis, Garret Gantvoort

Gary Toombs, vice-president, called the meeting to order.

Minutes from the November 06, 2004 meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report was given by Sue. The current balance was \$2,102.22 at the start of the year, but after canoe race related expenditures (insurance, ads, etc), the balance as of today is \$1,412.00.

Old Business: There was no old business to discuss.

New Business:

- 1. The Spring Canoe Race will be held on Saturday, April 16, 2005. Fran will send out e-mails asking members to contribute soup for the race. Sue will also make a few phone calls regarding the soup contributions. Fran will order the rolls, and Sue will pick them up. Jeff will take care of the application/registration form. Entry fees will be approximately the same as last year, \$11 for amateur and \$14 for pro. Prizes will be taken care of by Jeff and Sue. A price of \$2.00/non paddlers, \$1.00 for 6-10 year olds will be charged for the soup luncheon (the same as in 2004). Timers will be coordinated by Neil Toombs.
- 2. The expense of canoe race insurance was discussed. It is believed that the \$600 was not an unreasonable fee for the "one-day" race insurance. The insurance is purchased through the USCA.
- 3. Jeff felt that the entry fee for the canoe race is quite low as compared to other races. Jeff made the recommendation that the entry fee be raised next year to approximately \$15 for amateur and \$20 for pro.
- 4. Bicycle time trials will begin on April 13th, occurring the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month through October. Hill-climbs will commence on April 20 and will take place every 3rd Wednesday of the month. It was decided that the time trial course will remain the same as last year on County Route 48. Those present still thought that the intersection of Route 205 and 23 could not be safely negotiated by the cyclists.
- 5. The club century ride will be held on Sunday, September 11. The ride will start at 8:00 at the center level of the Oneonta Municipal Parking Garage.
- 6. It was decided that USPP will assist the General Clinton Canoe Relay Race on Sunday, May 29 by taking splits for the participating teams. USPP will be paid \$250 for this responsibility. Jeff Shultis will coordinate the volunteers for this event. Neil and Fran Toombs have already volunteered.
- 7. The date for the next meeting was not set.
