



How to get onto Cengage Brain and the Mind Tap platform for Students for Access to the OWLBook


1. Go to <http://www.cengagebrain.com>



2. Click "login" at the top right portion of the screen.




3. If you have a Cengagebrain account, enter you log in information then click the “log in” button. If you do not have an account, click Sign Up to get an account (it’s free).
